STEP 1:

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING?



Eligibility for subsidised training:

You are eligible for a subsidised training place if you have left school, your primary place of residence is in Western Australia and you are:

- *an Australian citizen; or*
- *holder of a sub-class 309, 444, 785, 790, or 820 visa;*
- *secondary holder of a temporary visa of sub-class 457 or 482 visa;*
- *holder of a Bridging Visa E (subclasses 050 and 051) where the visa holder has made a valid application for a visa of subclass 785 or 790;*
- *Ukraine citizens who are holders of a visa sub-class 449 or 786;*
- *Afghan citizens who are holders of a visa sub-class 449; and*
- *holders of a bridging visa who are eligible to work, and who have made a valid application for a subclass 866.*

** Please note that access to subsidised training is subject to availability.*

**Students who obtain in a funded place can only be enrolled in one funded course at a time.*

**The student fees are indicative only and are subject to change given individual circumstances at enrolment. Additional fees may apply such as student service and resource fees.*
