CERTIFICATE III IN UNDERGROUND METALLIFEROUS MINING

This qualification reflects the role of individuals such as shot firers, drillers and production operators, working in underground metalliferous mining, who perform tasks involving a broad range of skilled applications in a varied work context, using some discretion and judgement in selecting equipment, services or contingency measures.

Entry Requirements	Above 18 years old. Must be currently working in an underground mine site.
Duration	12-18 months - <i>The duration will vary depending on experience and elective units chosen.</i>
