

## LICENCE TO OPERATE A FORKLIFT TRUCK

## HIGH RISK LICENCE - (LF)

This unit specifies the skills and knowledge required to operate a forklift truck safely in accordance with all relevant legislative requirements. A person performing this work is required to hold a forklift truck High Risk Work Licence (HRWL).

Mine Training Australia is a Registered Training Organisation (RTO 51586) and a WorkSafe-approved High Risk Training Organisation. We will submit all High Risk Work Licences for individuals who have completed the training and have been deemed competent.
