

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING?



Eligibility for subsidised training:

You are eligible for a subsidised training place if you have left school, your primary place of residence is in Western Australia and you are:

- an Australian citizen; or
- holder of a sub-class 309, 444, 785, 790, or 820 visa;
- secondary holder of a temporary visa of sub-class 457or 482 visa;
- holder of a Bridging Visa E (subclasses 050 and 051) where the visa holder has made a valid application for a visa of subclass 785 or 790;
- Ukraine citizens who are holders of a visa sub-class 449 or 786;
- Afghan citizens who are holders of a visa sub-class 449; and
- holders of a bridging visa who are eligible to work, and who have made a valid application for a subclass 866.
- * Please note that access to subsidised training is subject to availability.
- *Students who obtain in a funded place can only be enrolled in one funded course at a time.
